











Home Learning

Writing	<p>Collect, illustrate and display key Tudor vocabulary.</p> 	<p>Research food eaten during the Tudor times and create a menu for royalty.</p> 	<p>Explore well known Tudors using BBC Bitesize and write your own “horrible history” style fact files.</p> 	<p>Write a newspaper article about a crime committed during the Tudor reign.</p> 
Maths	<p>Write the dates of the reigns of the Tudor monarchs in roman numerals.</p> 	<p>Invent some Tudor themed word problems. For example; You are planning a feast for Henry VIII. He has invited 420 people. For the meat course, one leg of mutton is enough for 3 people. How many legs of mutton will you need?</p>	<p>Create a maths game that tests the understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages.</p> 	<p>Create a bar graph which demonstrates the length of rein in the Tudor monarchy.</p>
