English

<u>Writing-</u> We will be writing a Newspaper report on the beheading of Anne Boleyn. We will learn to write 2 different forms of poetry, one based on Tudor Sonnets and the other on Palindromes.

<u>GPS-</u> Children will learn more about the structure of sentences and using the skills learnt within their writing. We will practise spelling patterns that occur frequently.

<u>Reading-</u>We will be reading The Last Wild' by Piers Torday. We will also read the sequel to Varjak Paw.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning how to create our own multiple choice quizzes and animate them using google slides. We will then upload them to Kahoot for testing.

Art/DT

Our focus this term will be portraits. We will consider the importance of symbols and colour before looking at the work of Hans Holbien. The children will then Draw, their own portrait.





<u>Term 6 - Year 5</u> Crime and Punishment



Maths

We will revise how to add and subtract decimals and investigate number sequences involving decimals.

Children will recap fluency skills such as dividing and multiplying by 10, 100 and 1000, also negative numbers.

We will learn how to measure capacity and volume.

We will estimate measurements and convert between units such as grams and kilograms or metres and kilometres.

R.E.

This term we will be looking at the Christian faith. We will look at the 10 commandments and how Christians show commitment to God.

Music

This term, we will learn about the renaissance period, Tudor music and instruments. We will learn to play and compose our own melodies and learn to sing Greensleeves.

<u>History</u>

This term, we will be studying Crime and Punishment through history. Children will compare how these have changed over time. We will pay close attention to the Tudor time period and how political and religious changes affected crime and punishment. Children will refer to prior learning in earlier year groups e.g. Anglo-Saxons, Romans.
